1. The Christian falls into legalism when he attempts to earn his salvation by obedience to the law of God
2. The Christian falls into legalism when he attempts to add supplements to the work of Christ
3. The Christian falls into legalism when his external works are not accompanied by a corresponding internal attitude
4. The Christian falls into legalism when he turns into a commandment what should be treated as preference for each believer
5. The Christian falls into legalism when he requires or demands obedience to the law of God with the same rigidity of the civil law
6. The Christian fall into legalism when he creates traditions that morph into commandments
7. The Christian falls into legalism when he majors on the minors
8. Legalism is to live to comply with the law rather than to develop a relationship to Christ: law and mercy personified

Conclusion:

- The Christian does not want to be a legalist by becoming an antinomianist
