Important reminders in dealing with the sin of homosexuality (from part 1):

- · We must keep the gospel central in our response to homosexuality
- · We must hate sin, but love sinners
- We must remember that sinners just like us struggle with homosexual temptation and sin
- · Disagreement is not hate, fear, or lack of love

I. The Bible is the Authoritative Truth of God

2 Tim. 3:16-17; Ju. 21:25; Rom. 8:7; 1 Cor. 2:14; 2 Cor. 4:4; Gal. 6:7; Prov. 14:12

Absolute truth only comes from God. It is not determined by polls, politicians, protesters, or pastors. God is the author of truth and morality!

A person's rejection of the Bible and God's moral absolutes does not diminish the truth of Scripture one iota, nor does it eliminate our accountability for either receiving it or rejecting it.

God has the first and final word on homosexuality!

II. The Bible Teaches that Homosexuality is Sin

All sexual activity outside the bounds of a marital covenant between a man and a woman is sin!

A. Before the Law

Gen. 1:27,28; 2:18,21-25; Gen. 19 (cf. Heb. 13:4; 2 Pet. 2:6,7; Jude 7)

God makes it very clear—He made them (Adam and Eve) male and female. Nothing in the middle. There are only two distinct genders that God created and assigns at conception. He said marriage is when a male and female come together and create a union for life. That is marriage. Not two men or two women getting "married".

The expression of sexual love is a pure and precious gift from God and is to take place only between one man and one woman who are married to each other. That is the only kind of physical intimacy that God declares to be holy.

B. In the Law

Lev. 18:22; 20:13

The Bible calls the practice of homosexuality an "abomination" and a "detestable act."

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C. In the New Testament

Rom. 1:24-27; 1 Cor. 6:9-11; 1 Tim. 1:9,10; Gal. 5:19-21

"In our fallen world, we all struggle with inclinations to express our sexuality in sinful ways. Christ has come to rescue homosexual people, no less than heterosexual people, from their soul-killing idolatry so that we might live forgiven, joyful, obedient, and triumphant lives as disciples of Jesus." (John Piper)

III. Divine Judgment—Now and Later

Rom. 1:27; 1 Thess. 4:3-8; Heb. 13:4; 1 Cor. 6:9,10; Gen. 19; Rev. 21:8; 22:15

We will all answer to God for our views and practices relative to our sexual behavior. All the lies that people have concocted about gender, marriage, and sex will one day be silenced and judged by God.

IV. Our Need for Conviction and Compassion

lsa. 5:20; Prov. 17:15; 2 Tim. 3:13-17; Eph. 4:15; 1 Cor. 6:11; Lk. 9:51-56; 18:9-14

If the conservative's sin is that they have fancied themselves more judging than God, the liberal's sin is that they have fancied that they can be more kind than God's law. As a harsh conservative, the surgeon curses the patient and slashes him ruthlessly; as a mushy liberal, he glibly pronounces the patient healthy simply to spare him the pain of surgery, however necessary it is to live.
